

INTRODUCTION • WHO ARE THE GRIMSBY GENTLEMEN?

Thank you for taking the time to read the 2014 Grimsby Gentlemen Rugby Football Club Sponsorship Kit.

The Grimsby Gentlemen Rugby Football Club (GGRFC) is a local rugby club dedicated to the playing and development of the game of rugby within Grimsby and neighbouring communities. We play in the Niagara Rugby Union, competing against teams from all across Southern Ontario.

The GGRFC senior team consists of males ages 18 - 50; white and blue collar workers from various ethnic groups with a wide variety of family situations. The flag rugby team consists of boys and girls ages 6-12. The club will be expanding to include a junior contact team and a senior women's team along with the potential for a junior girls' team in 2014.

Currently, the GGRFC is renovating Away Public School into a community centre that has been their home for the last 7 years. Over those 7 years, the GGRFC has been able to complete smaller projects on their own and with help from various sources and sponsors. It is their goal to have the clubhouse finished in 2014 so they can host various community sporting and social events.



JUST WHAT IS RUGBY?

Rugby football is a competitive and extremely physical team sport. A truly international pastime, it is played in over 100 countries and is regarded as the 4th largest participant sport in the world today.

The distinctive features of a rugby game are the egg-shaped ball and the fact that the ball is only allowed to pass laterally or backwards, so that only running with the ball or kicking it can gain ground. Set pieces of the game include the scrum, where packs of opposing players push against each other for possession and the line out where lines of players attempt to catch the ball thrown from the sidelines. Scoring is by either grounding the ball at the opponents' end of the field, or kicking it between upright posts.

The legendary origin of Rugby football, whereby a young man named William Webb Ellis "picked up the ball and ran", while playing soccer at the Rugby School (in Rugby, England) is often considered to be a myth. There were no standard rules for football during Webb Ellis's time at Rugby (1816-1825) and most varieties involved carrying the ball and the story first appeared in 1876 some four years after his death. However, the trophy for the Rugby Union World Cup is named the Webb Ellis Trophy in his honour and a plaque at the school commemorates his achievement.

The Grimsby Gentlemen Rugby Football Club is a not for profit organization. No player, official or associate of the club is paid for his or her involvement.
